- (b) Own choice - a contrasting piece not to exceed 15 minutes.

2nd Prize: Silver medal

- (b) C.M. Widor: 2nd movt - Adagio - from Symphony No.6 in g minor, Op.42 No.2

13.04 Junior Organ

Sarah Cooper Cup.

Performers under 18 years.

1st Prize: Cup and Gold Medal

2nd Prize: Silver Medal

Entrance: €40

Test:

- (a) H Distler: Spielstück Op. 18 No.1, from *A Graded Anthology for Organ*, Book 4 by Anne Marsden Thomas
- (b) C.H. Rinck: Trio in F, from *A Graded Anthology for Organ*, Book 4 by Anne Marsden Thomas

13.05 Stanford Prize

Open to both Junior and Senior competitors.

Entrance: €50
